Dr. Cihaner was born in Ankara, Turkey, in 1977. He graduated from Department of Chemistry at Middle East Technical University (METU) in 1998 and then he joined Prof. Dr. Ahmet M. Önal's Research Group at METU. He did his M.Sc (2000) and Ph.D. (2004) on the synthesis of conjugated polymers and their applications. He became a research assistant in 1999 and an assistant professor in 2004. He is working as a professor of Chemical Engineering and Applied Chemistry at Atilim University since 2014. His research work is focused on the design and synthesis of functional materials and unnatural products and their applications, such as electrochromic devices, erasable papers, hydrophobic surfaces, molecular switches and sensors. Also, he is interested in the synthesis of novel luminol-type chemiluminescent compounds and their application in forensic science. He has more than 70 papers on international journals and his awards include Scientific & Technical Research Council of Turkey (TÜBİTAK) Incentive Award (2015), Middle East Technical University (METU) Prof. Dr. Mustafa Parlar Foundation Research Incentive Award (2012), FABED Outstanding Young Scientist Award (2012) and Turkish Academy of Sciences Outstanding Young Scientists Award (TÜBA-GEBİP) (2010).
